



**PROVINCIAL WINTER FAIR RULES
AND REGULATIONS – 2009
HORSE DIVISION**



1. All 4-H Horse Club Members participating in PWF must have their horses in the barn before 8:00 PM on Thursday evening, September 24, 20089
2. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning his/her stall at the end of the show.
3. There will be an entry fee of \$ 60.00 (plus GST) per member, and an exhibitor fee of \$5.00 per member (plus GST).
4. Entry fees, less \$15.00 office charge, will be refunded if a veterinarian or doctor's certificate is received at the office within 7 days of the beginning of the Fair.
5. Each exhibitor must pay a \$5.00 exhibitor's fee which is to be included with each entry form.
6. All 4-H Horse Club members must use their achievement project in order to participate in the Provincial Winter Fair.
7. In order to qualify for aggregate at Provincial Winter Fair, each horse exhibitor will be required to:
 - a) Participate in Horse Judging
 - b) Participate in Horse Showmanship
 - c) * Participate in his/her registered unit classes. (Including trail, pleasure and equitation in order to accumulate his or her aggregate scores). * Amendments to be considered for 2 A/B. Regular members with regards to safety in Trail Courses.
8. Each exhibitor shall be responsible for having his or her animal ready when a class is called.
9. No exhibitor may talk to the Judge during the judging of a class, unless asked a specific question by the Judge.
10. All decisions on these rules shall be made by the Provincial Winter Fair Grievance Committee and shall be considered final.
11. All Dress, Tack & Equipment requirements are as per BC 4-H rules.
12. It is mandatory for every club entered in PWF to enter one team in their division's Show & Fitting provided they have an eligible member, and these Show & Fitting points will count towards Club Aggregate points.
13. Each horse club entered must provide two volunteers (parents) to help as needed, with the events at Provincial Winter Fair. Names to be submitted with entries.
14. No dismantling of stalls prior to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday. If stalls are dismantled, the offending club will be fined \$100.00.
15. All initial bedding to be provided by the KXA, further bedding is at the expense of the member or 4-H club.
